
Parents onsite and around the school perimeter

A reminder that until further notice school will be an Adult Free Zone with the exception of school staff and essential workers. This means that we need your support to ensure that you do not attend on-site unless absolutely necessary. If attendance is absolutely necessary please contact the school on 5443 2011 prior to attending.

Please remember current social distancing standards when waiting at drop-off and pick-up points. We request that parents remain in cars at all times other than when meeting their child at the designated drop-off and pick-up space. Please do not use these spaces as a chance for a social catch up.

Student Drop off - Morning

As per normal we will have all school access points open for drop off and pick up. The roundabout will be available to use in the mornings only. The top car park (visitor car park) will be for staff access only.



School staff will be available at each of the SEE OUR SCHOOL ZONE ONLINE access points to support your children getting to their classrooms if required.

Student Pick Up - Afternoon

Children will be supervised to move to their designated pick up point to meet their parent / carer. Please ensure that you have organised this with your child prior.

Returning of school devices

If you have borrowed a school device to support remote learning please send this to school with your child. Please ask your child to return it to the front office.

As these devices are used as teaching tools in our classrooms it is important that these are returned to school straight away. As always your support with this is appreciated.

Other health and safety measures

We are providing facilities for regular handwashing and ensuring that hand sanitiser is provided in every occupied room.

We have prioritised increased cleaning of high-touch areas and shared equipment. Playground equipment will be available for use. All students will practise hand hygiene before and after use.

We have, and will continue to consider the necessity of using shared equipment during this time. If used, strict hand hygiene will be followed before and after use.

Water Bottles

Students should bring their own water bottle for use at school as students will not be drinking directly from drinking fountains at this time. Taps may be used to refill water bottles.

Outside School Hours Care
