Well done everyone on a successful return to onsite learning. In particular the Grades 3, 4, 5 and 6 students and staff. Even though it was only for a couple of days it was great to see everyone excited to be back onsite and in their classrooms.

SCHOOL OPERATIONS

Until further notice school will continue to be an Adult Free Zone with the exception of school staff and essential workers. This means that we need your support to ensure that you do not attend on-site unless absolutely necessary. If attendance is absolutely necessary please contact the school on 5443 2011 prior to attending.

Face Masks

From Monday October 18 It is a requirement that all students in Grades 3, 4, 5 and 6 wear a face mask when at school indoors. An email has been sent to all families outlining the Chief Health Officer's requirements regarding wearing masks. We appreciate your assistance with this new direction from the Chief Health Officer.

Staggered Return to School

For this week of school October 18 - 22, the following attendance is required.

Grades Prep - 2

All students in Grades Prep to 2 are expected to attend school every day, unless unwell.

Grades 3 & 4

Students in Grades 3 & 4 attend onsite face-to-face Tuesday and Wednesday (Remote and Flexible Learning Monday, Thursday & Friday).

Grades 5 & 6

Students in Grades 5 & 6 attend onsite face-to-face Thursday and Friday (Remote and Flexible Learning Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday).

Please note, schools are not expected to provide remote learning where parents elect to keep their children at home, except where this is based on medical advice, if this is the case, please contact the school on 5443 2011.

Onsite Supervision

A reminder that onsite supervision is available for eligible students in grades 3 to 6 on the days that they are not attending school.

'If you can work from home, you should work from home'.

We request that parents remain in cars at all times other than when meeting their child at the designated drop-off and pick-up space. Please do not use these spaces as a chance for a social catch up.

Student Drop Off - Morning

As per normal we will have all school access points open for drop off and pick up. The roundabout will be available to use in the mornings only. The drop-off area has been increased. Students may exit between the green flags. The top car park (visitor car park) is for staff access only.

School staff will be available at each of the access points to support your child getting to their classrooms if required.

Student Collection - Afternoon

Children will be supervised to move to their designated collection point to meet their parent / carer. Please ensure that you have organised this with your child prior.

Please be aware that there are limited carparks on the driveway off the Crook Street entrance. Please be patient whilst waiting for a carpark.

Other Health and Safety Measures

We are providing facilities for regular handwashing and ensuring that hand sanitiser is provided in every occupied room.

We have prioritised increased cleaning of high-touch areas and shared equipment.

Playground equipment is available for use. All students will practise hand hygiene before and after use.

We have, and will continue to consider the necessity of using shared equipment during this time. If used, strict hand hygiene will be followed before and after use.

Outside School Hours Care

HATS ON

A reminder that from the beginning of September, it is DET and school policy that green broad brim or bucket hats are worn outside. We have reminded all students that it is time to have hats on again, and we look forward to your support in encouraging your children to wear their hats.

Children without hats will be required to sit in the amphitheatre during lunchtimes, so they are protected from the sun.

PREP 2022 - ENROLMENT

All parents who intend to enrol their child in Grade Prep at Kennington Primary School in 2022, need to collect an Enrolment Pack from the school office. The pack includes information pertinent to KPS including the Great Start Transition Program and the official school enrolment form. The enrolment form and a copy of your child's birth certificate and immunisation record must be returned to school.

If your child has additional needs, including a medical diagnosis, language difficulties, is involved with any Early Intervention services, or if you just have a worry or concern about your child, please make an appointment to see me as soon as possible. If your child is hearing impaired please contact Mrs Brooke Howman, who works in the Deaf Facility through the school office.
