Student-Parent-Teacher Learning Conference are a major part of Kennington Primary School's assessment and reporting processes. The aims of the conference are;


- To speak with you about your child's learning achievements particularly in Literacy and Numeracy

Each class have completed a 2-minute dance with the Preps working toegther on two dances between all classes. We look forward to presenting out Dance Celebration and hope you can come and support!


PRODUCTION

We are looking forward to working with another talented team this year, Miss Rothacker and the Grade 5/6 teachers.




