STUDENT-PARENT-TEACHER LEARNING CONFERENCE BOOKINGS OPEN

Student-Parent-Teacher Learning Conference are a major part of Kennington Primary School's assessment and reporting processes. The aims of the conference are;

To speak with you about your child's learning achievements particularly in Literacy and Numeracy

- To show your child's work samples and assessment data
- To speak with you about your child's learning goals for Term 4.

The Student-Parent-Teacher Learning Conferences (15 minutes) will be held from 3:30pm until 7:00pm on Monday September 4, Tuesday September 5, and Wednesday September 6.

Some classroom teachers will also offer times before school, please check individual schedules for details.

Conferences will take place in your child's classroom or online.

If you would like to complete your conference online via Webex, please email your classroom teacher once you have made your booking in Sentral.

Students must wear school uniform to their conference.

Please book meeting times via the Sentral Parent Portal or Sentral Parent App. How to book information can be found in the 'Resources' tab under 'How to use Sentral'.

If booking two or more appointments, please give yourself time to move from classroom to classroom.

RESPECTFUL RELATIONSHIPS TOPIC 2 – POSITIVE COPING

Learning activities in this topic provide opportunities for students to identify and discuss different types of coping strategies. When children and young people develop a language around coping, they are more likely to be able to understand and deliberately utilise a range of productive coping strategies and diminish their use of unproductive coping strategies. Students learn to extend their repertoire of coping strategies and benefit from critically reflecting on their own choices and being exposed to alternative options. Activities introduce students to the concept of self-talk and practice using positive self-talk to approach and manage challenging situations. Positive self-talk is a key strategy for coping with negative thoughts, emotions and events. It is associated with greater persistence in the face of challenge, and can be learnt or strengthened through practice.

SCHOOL COUNCIL NEWS

The Kennington Primary School council met on Monday evening to discuss all things governance and approve a couple of days that are coming up in term 4.

The first day of term 4, Monday October 2 has been approved as a Professional Practice Day for all teachers, this means that it will be a pupil free day.

Also approved was a Report Writing Day as per the Victorian Government Schools Agreement 2022, this will occur on Wednesday November 29.


