BEFORE SCHOOL SUPERVISION

A reminder to all families and students that if students arrive to school prior to classes beginning at 8:50am they have a couple of options. If students are with their parents, then they can stay with them until the bell goes. If students are by themselves, they can attend Morning Club Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. EMERGENCY CONTACT NUMBERS

From time to time, we need to contact parents for a myriad of reasons including sick children or to pass on important information or to arrange a meeting. Please ensure that when you change your contact details or the emergency contact's details, the office is informed immediately.

TRAFFIC SAFETY REMINDER

The safety of our children is paramount, and by following a few simple guidelines, we can make a significant difference.

First and foremost, please obey speed limits and be vigilant, especially in school zones where children may dart out unpredictably. Always stop for school buses when their stop signs are out and lights are flashing, ensuring the safety of students boarding or exiting.

Practice patience when dropping off or picking up your children. Avoid double parking, blocking driveways, or making U-turns in these areas, as they create unnecessary hazards. We encourage parking walking distance from the school and allow your children to walk from the car, this can reduce congestion around the school.

RESPECTFUL RELATIONSHIPS TOPIC 3 – POSITIVE COPING

Learning activities in this topic provide opportunities for students to identify and discuss different types of coping strategies. When children and young people develop a language around coping, they are more likely to be able to understand and deliberately utilise a range of productive coping strategies and diminish their use of unproductive coping strategies.

Students learn to extend their repertoire of coping strategies and benefit from critically reflecting on their own choices and being exposed to alternative options. Activities introduce students to the concept of self-talk and practice using positive self-talk to approach and manage challenging situations.

Positive self-talk is a key strategy for coping with negative thoughts, emotions, and events. It is associated with greater persistence in the face of challenge and can be learnt or strengthened through practice.

JUNIOR ATHLETICS DAY

On Tuesday (7/11) KPS will be holding the Junior School Athletics Carnival. This event will be held here at school and will run for most of the school day. Students are encouraged to wear their house colours for the event, but this is not compulsory (KPS uniform if not wearing house colours please).

Throughout the term the students have been practicing all of the events / skills required to compete on the day.

Over the course of the day the students will have an opportunity to run, jump, throw and generally have a great time with their peers. Parents / Carers are able to come along and watch for part of the day, events will be underway from approximately 9:20 and will conclude around 1pm (with a break at normal recess time of 10:50).

The students are very excited to participate in this event and have been very busy practicing in PE and Sport sessions this term.


