Great news... As part of our Crazy Colour Fun Run, we have secured Ninja Warrior activities for student to participate in prior to the colour run!




For the Crazy Colour Fun Run, we suggest that you purchase a cheap white T-Shirt for your children to participate in on the day.

Once a conference note has been completed by a teacher, **parents will be notified via email** to let you know when to check the Sentral App.

Existing Conference Notes

We are in the process of merging students existing conference notes into the new format. You will be notified when this process is complete.

SUNSMART - SLAP ON A HAT

The skin on your face, neck and ears is much thinner and more sensitive to UV damage than other skin on your body.

School council approved hats can be purchased from our uniform supplier, LOWES at the Marketplace, and at our front office.

Please ensure your child has a clearly named water bottle, filled with water, for use at school, every day. The drink bottle is kept in the classroom and is easily accessible during learning time.

It can be refilled as needed during break times. Having a drink bottle in the classroom avoids loss of learning time when children need to exit the room to drink from a bubbler.

A reminder to all families and students that if students arrive to school prior to classes beginning at 8:50am they have a couple of options. If students are with their parents, then they can stay with them until the bell goes.

If students are by themselves, they can attend Morning Club Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Or on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday they can attend Breakfast Club.

Other than these options, all students are required to go to the amphitheatre and wait for the bell. Please remember that the playground equipment is not to be used during this time.

TRAFFIC SAFETY REMINDER

The safety of our children is paramount, and by following a few simple guidelines, we can make a significant difference.

First and foremost, please obey speed limits and be vigilant, especially in school zones where children may dart out unpredictably. Always stop for school buses when their stop signs are out and lights are flashing, ensuring the safety of students boarding or exiting.

Practice patience when dropping off or picking up your children. Avoid double parking, blocking driveways, or making U-turns in these areas, as they create unnecessary hazards. We encourage parking walking distance from the school and allow your children to walk from the car, this can reduce congestion around the school.

Finally, be a role model for your kids. Demonstrate responsible driving habits and remind them of the importance of safety. Together, we can ensure our school zones are safe for learning and growing.

RESPECTFUL RELATIONSHIPS TOPIC 6 – HELP SEEKING

Learning activities in this topic area are designed to help students discuss the importance of seeking help and providing peer support when dealing with problems that are too big to solve alone.

This helps to normalise and destigmatise help-seeking behaviour. Scenario-based activities help students identify situations in which help should be sought, identify trusted sources of help, and practice seeking help from peers and adults.

Well done boys!




