
All our Grade Six students will participate in the Statewide Transition Day as well, by visiting their Secondary Schools on this day.

The safety of our children is paramount, and by following a few simple guidelines, we can make a significant difference.

First and foremost, please obey speed limits and be vigilant, especially in school zones where children may dart out unpredictably. Always stop for school buses when their stop signs are out and lights are flashing, ensuring the safety of students boarding or exiting.

Practice patience when dropping off or picking up your children. Avoid double parking, blocking driveways, or making U-turns in these areas, as they create unnecessary hazards. We encourage parking walking distance from the school and allow your children to walk from the car, this can reduce congestion around the school.

Finally, be a role model for your kids. Demonstrate responsible driving habits and remind them of the importance of safety. Together, we can ensure our school zones are safe for learning and growing.

A reminder to all families that the last day of term 4 is on Wednesday December 20. Please remember that on this day school finishes at 1:00pm.

#### IMPORTANT DATES FOR BEGINNING OF 2024

We are currently in preparation for 2024 and have some very important dates to announce for the beginning of the year.

Monday January 29 – All staff begin, curriculum day for students.

Tuesday January 30 – Meet the teacher interviews (all students including prep), students only to attend for their interview in uniform with their parents. For families with Prep students, you will be allocated a time to meet your teacher. For families with students in grade 1-6 bookings will be available on Sentral in the new year.

Wednesday January 31 – Students in grades 1-6 start classes. Prep students attend for literacy and numeracy interviews with Prep teachers (via bookings). Classes as normal for all other students.

Thursday February 1 – First full day of classes for Prep students. Classes as normal for all other students.

#### SUNSMART - SLAP ON A HAT

The skin on your face, neck and ears is much thinner and more sensitive to UV damage than other skin on your body.

School council approved hats can be purchased from our uniform supplier, LOWES at the Marketplace, and at our front office.

Please ensure your child has a clearly named water bottle, filled with water, for use at school, every day. The drink bottle is kept in the classroom and is easily accessible during learning time.

It can be refilled as needed during break times. Having a drink bottle in the classroom avoids loss of learning time when children need to exit the room to drink from a bubbler.

#### RESPECTFUL RELATIONSHIPS TOPIC 8 – POSITIVE GENDER RELATIONS

Learning activities within this topic focus on building an understanding of the effects of family violence and focus on the standards associated with respectful relationships.

Students develop the skills needed to solve problems, set boundaries within relationships, and play an active role within the prevention of family violence.


They develop peer support and helpseeking skills that can be applied in response to situations involving genderbased violence in family, peer, community, or on-line relationships.
