The Department does not provide

personal accident insurance for students.

Parents and guardians are responsible for paying the cost of medical treatment for injured students, including any transport costs, unless the injury is caused by the negligence (carelessness) of the Department or school council employee or volunteer. Students' accident insurance policies are available from the private insurance market.

These cover a range of medical expenses not covered by Medicare. They can be obtained by parents for individual students.

Parents of students at Kennington Primary School are reminded that Kennington Primary School does not have a whole of school policy.


PARENTS AND FRIENDS' - AGM

STAY SUN SMART THIS SEASON!

Over the last week we have had several extremely hot days, therefore it's essential to remember the importance of staying sun smart. With increased outdoor activities, it's crucial to protect ourselves from the harmful effects of the sun's UV rays.

Here are a few friendly reminders to help keep you and your family safe while enjoying the sunshine:

- 1. Slip on protective clothing: Wear lightweight, long-sleeved shirts, pants, and wide-brimmed hats to shield your skin from direct sunlight.
- 2. Slop on sunscreen: Apply sunscreen generously to all exposed skin, including your face, neck, and ears. Remember to reapply every two hours, especially after swimming or sweating.
- 3. Slap on a hat: Protect your face, neck, and ears with a wide-brimmed hat or a cap with a flap that covers your neck.
- 4. Seek shade: Find shade, especially during the peak sun hours between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. when UV rays are strongest.
- 5. Slide on sunglasses: Choose sunglasses that provide 100% UV protection to shield your eyes from harmful UV rays and reduce the risk of eye damage.
- 6. Stay hydrated: Drink plenty of water throughout the day to stay hydrated, especially when participating in outdoor activities.

STUDENT ABSENCE PROGRAM (SMS)

We use Sentral Student Management Program to track student absences. This program allows us to send an SMS message to parents who have a child/children absent from school without an explanation. The message notifies the parent that the child is absent and asks that they notify the school as to the reason why.

Parents can either return an SMS with the absence reason, log the absence reason on the Sentral App or telephone the school on 5443 2011 and leave a message at the office.

This Student Absence Program hopefully reduces the number of students with unexplained absences.

Days absent per semester (Two Terms)		
0 - 6 days	This is the normal range for school absence.	
7 – 10 days	This attendance is below average. TYhis student could miss over one year of schooling from Prep to Year 10.	
11 – 20 days	This attendance rate is poor. This student could miss over two years of schooling from Prep to Year 10	
20+ Days	This attendance rate is very poor. This student could miss over two and a half years of schooling from Prep to Year 10	


If you are aware in advance that your child is going to be absent, please add it to the Sentral App, send a note to the school or phone the school. If the absence is unexpected the school should be advised either via a phone call on the morning of the absence or by a note when your child returns to school. Calls to the school can be made after 8:30am. Calls to the school or notes must be provided by parent/carer. In the case where your child has several unexplained absences you will receive a letter asking for an explanation of the absences.

We ask you in advance for your cooperation in this matter, as it is very important that we work together to establish good attendance patterns for your child/ren.
