Problem-solving skills are an important part of the coping repertoire. The classroom program provides a number of learning activities to develop students' problem-solving skills. The activities in the program assist students to develop their critical and creative thinking skills, and to apply them to scenarios exploring personal, social and ethical dilemmas.

MATHEMATICS HOME LEARNING 2024

Mathematics Home Learning in 2024 will look quite different to way that maths homework was presented in the past at Kennington Primary School. This year we are really focussing on a need within the school and that need is for students to become fluent with recalling sets of number facts and at using efficient computation strategies to solve problems.

Number Fluency at KPS is critical to student success in Mathematics. Number fluency is the ability to understand the concept of numbers and then use this conceptual understanding to recall and apply number knowledge efficiently and accurately. At KPS this term, we have introduced a whole school, systematic approach to providing Mathematics Home Learning practise aimed at building every students' number fluency. Students at KPS will be provided with regular homework practise and are encouraged to practise 3 or 4 times a week for 10 minutes each time to support their automatic recall of addition and subtraction facts as well as multiplication and division. The program is differentiated, meaning that students will participate at their own level, and progress through the levels at their own pace.

Teachers will have explicitly taught the computation strategy associated with the set of facts your child is asked to practise. You can support your child at home with this Mathematics Home Learning by encouraging them to practise on a regular basis and by using the strategy that is on the home learning sheet. Students can practise by filling in part of the worksheet and then progress onto solving the equations mentally. Spaced regular practise is the key to helping children become confident and fluent. If your child experiences any difficulty, please have your child communicate this to the classroom teacher or alternatively you could sent an email.

Each age group will have an identification colour name tag;

When the children have finished, they will receive their finishing time which is written on their name tag. They will then proceed immediately to the recording table in finishing order to have their name, time and team recorded. After each group race has finished no child is to leave the finishing area. Children will return to school in age groups.

All children are welcome to wear their house colours & black shorts (or their KPS uniform – this is not an out of uniform day), hat and appropriate footwear to school. If your child is unable to participate a note is required. Children can bring their own drinks in a named drink bottle with them to the run at the reservoir. Permission for this activity has already been given by you through the Major Sporting Events permission form at the beginning of 2024.
